DIRECTIONS

- 1. You need to <u>draw a diagram of a NEW plane design</u> that includes all the important parts of a plane (see the diagram we went over in our flight unit). It should be unique and neatly done!
- 2. Your plane must be designed to do something **BETTER** than your average plane (e.g. you could design it with special lightweight material to make it weigh less, therefore the plane will be easier to get off the ground).
- 3. Your plane must include at least **THREE** unique features that help it achieve its goal (e.g. to fly faster, you designed a more streamlined nose).
- 4. Your plane should look NICE and look UNIQUE. Make it interesting and creative! Please include at least **TWO creative features** (e.g. it could have a mural of The Hobbit painted on the fuselage). Think of a creative name and write it in large letters at the top of your design.
- 5. You are handing in two things:
 - a. One-page, full-colour design that has LABELLED parts and the name of your plane
 - b. A ONE-PAGE write-up (stapled to the design) that includes
 - i. What is special about your plane (your goal)
 - ii. How your plane design will help you achieve that goal (e.g. materials used). You MUST talk about the four forces of flight here.
 - iii. How much the plane will cost.
 - iv. How your plane will be **ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY.**
